**SCHENGEN/NATIONAL VISA**  
**LIST OF DOCUMENTS TO BE PRESENTED BY VISA APPLICANTS**  
**FAMILY MEMBERS OF EU/EEA NATIONALS AND SWISS NATIONALS**

**THE RULES DO NOT APPLY TO THE FAMILY MEMBERS OF POLISH CITIZENS\***

If you are a family member of an EU/Iceland/Liechtenstein/Norway or Swiss national you shall benefit from a simplified and accelerated visa procedure, including exemption from the visa fee, as long as you meet the following criteria:

- (1) You are a family member (this includes a spouse, registered partner, child who is under 21 or a depending family member) of an EU/Iceland/Liechtenstein/Norway or Swiss national (or of his/her spouse/registered partner); AND
- (2) That EU/Iceland/Liechtenstein/Norway or Swiss national is residing in Poland or travelling there to take up residence; AND
- (3) You are accompanying the EU/Iceland/Liechtenstein/Norway or Swiss national or planning to join him/her for residence.

The visa should be applied for at the Embassy of the Republic of Poland in New Delhi . The applicant should register for an appointment at [www.e-konsulat.gov.pl](http://www.e-konsulat.gov.pl). The applicant can contact the Consular Division at +91 11 414 96 917/904 Monday to Friday between 9.30 and 10.30 to have an immediate appointment arranged (please be ready for registration online when you contact us). The applicant is waived from the obligation to submit the documents in person. The visa will be issued within 3 working days.

Please note:

To qualify for the facilitation, original documents proving that the applicant is a family member should be provided.

**DOCUMENTS TO BE SUBMITTED BY ALL VISA APPLICANTS:**

- a. The **application form** filled in online at [www.e-konsulat.gov.pl](http://www.e-konsulat.gov.pl) in Polish or English language, printed out and signed by the applicant.
- b. Original **passport**/travel document with copies of the first/last/observation/correction pages.

Please note:

- travel document should contain at least two blank pages;
- the validity of the travel document should extend at least 3 months after the intended date of departure from Schengen area;
- travel document should have been issued within the previous 10 years;
- in addition, as informed by the Indian Authorities, the Schengen states' consulates do not accept:
  - (1) handwritten or not machine readable Indian passports issued after 01/04/2010;
  - (2) Indian passports that contain a manual entry (observation) made after 01/04/2010 if the biographical data (biodata) of the passport holder were changed.

\*The procedure applies only to those EU/EEA and Swiss Nationals that reside in another Member State than that of which he/she is a national. It does not apply to Polish citizens residing in Poland. If you are a family member of a Polish citizen residing in another Member State, please apply for the visa in the Embassy/Consulate of that Member State.

c. One (1) **photograph** in accordance with the standards presented [here](#).

Please note:

- improper photographs will not be accepted.

d. Supporting documents:

Documents proving that:

- the visa applicant is a family member (e.g. original marriage certificate/birth certificate issued by the Member State of nationality; proof of dependency, serious health grounds, durability of partnerships) + one (1) copy;
- the visa applicant accompanies or joins the EU/EEA or Swiss citizen (e.g. a proof that the EU citizen already resides in Poland or a confirmation that the EU citizen will travel to Poland).
- copy of the passport or identity document of the EU/EEA or Swiss citizen.
